


The Drug Cost Iceberg: More Than Meets the Eye

Americans take 5 or more prescription drugs


82% of respondents in a recent survey identified medical costs as their biggest financial challenge

- Cost paid by the patient Copayments
 - Coinsurance
 - Deductibles
- Other payers
- Insurance Companies
 - Employers Government

illustrates the two components of drug pricing


The Drug Cost Iceberg

Two approaches to lower




