





## Center for Value-Based Insurance Design at the University of Michigan Gap Year Program

The University of Michigan Center for Value-Based Insurance Design (V-BID Center) is currently seeking applicants for the 2020-2021 V-BID Center Gap Year Program. This is a paid position located at the University of Michigan North Campus Research Complex (NCRC) in Ann Arbor, MI. The work commitment is expected to be 30 to 35 hours per week. The position is scheduled to begin June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 and run through the end of April 2021. There is some flexibility to accommodate individual schedules and the start date may vary depending on social distancing restrictions.

The V-BID Center mission is to improve health outcomes and contain costs by aligning stakeholders around value. By leading in research, development, and advocacy, the V-BID Center has inspired important public policy ventures at the heart of the national health care reform debate.

The V-BID Center Gap Year Program offers recent graduates from across the country the opportunity to integrate themselves into the vast, fast-paced world of public health policy. By joining our multidisciplinary team, students will participate in hands-on, collaborative experiences while gaining a better understanding of various facets of health care policy. Throughout the year, each student and their unique contributions will become an integral asset to our work. Upon completion of their time at the V-BID Center, students will also join our V-BID alumni network which include 60 previous students passionate about health care reform.
